

Year 4 Knowledge Map - Advent 1

We will also be looking at how puberty effects the body and our emotions.





Art

The Elements of Art:



Line is the most basic element of art – without lines other elements cannot be created.



When a line meets up to enclose a space, a shape is formed.



The way in which art feels or would seem to feel to the touch, like smooth, rough,

or bumpy.



Form is a step up from shape as we now add depth to create a three dimensional design.



Colour is created when light is reflected into the viewer's eye.

Lesson 2 - To be able to construct and interpret a variety of food chains.


Lesson 3 - To identify the different types of teeth in humans and identify their functions.


Lesson 4 - To explore different ways of keeping teeth healthy.

Food Chain











KEY WORDS

Herbivore: Animals that only eat plants.

Carnivores: Animals that eat other animals.

Omnivore: Animals that eat both plants and animals.

Producer: Animals that make their own food using sunlight.

Consumer: Animals that eat produces (plants) and other animals.

Food Chain: A food chain shows how energy moves from one living thing to another.

Canine: These are the pointy teeth near the front of your mouth. They help you rip food like meat.

Incisor: These are the flat teeth right at the front of your mouth. They help you bite into food, like an apple

Molar: These are the big, flat teeth at the back of your mouth. They help you crush and chew food.

Pre-molar: These are the teeth between the canines and molars. They help you chew and grind food.

Nutrients: The parts of food that your body needs to stay healthy and grow.

The digestive system: The group of body parts that helps break down food, take in the nutrients, and get rid of the waste.
