English

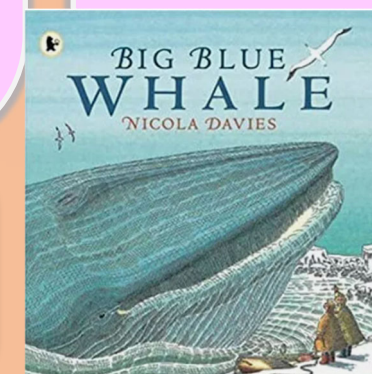
In English, we will be reading the story the Big Blue Whale and will be learning to write a Non-Chronological Report.

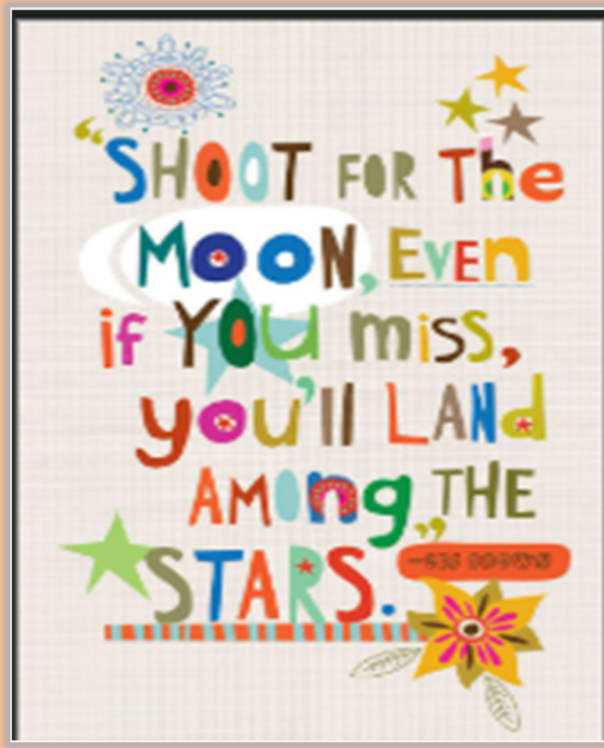
The features of a Non-Chronological Report are:
