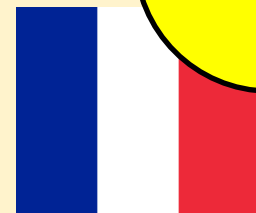
## **Earth and space vocabulary includes terms like:**
